1. SMART AND SKILLED POLICY FOR THE DELIVERY OF THE CERTIFICATE IV IN TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT (TAE40116) – VERSION 2.0 RELEASED

The Department has updated the *Smart and Skilled Policy for the Delivery of the Certificate IV in Training and Assessment (TAE40116)*, a copy of which (Version 2.0) is attached to this Update.

The policy now clarifies that students who are not currently qualified assessors or trainers, but who hold an Assessor Skills Set, are eligible to complete the full or part qualification to become a qualified trainer.

The updated policy continues to specify that under no circumstances can individuals who are qualified assessors or trainers and hold the previous qualification or skill set access Smart and Skilled funded training. They cannot be upskilled into the full qualification (TAE40116 – Certificate IV in Training and Assessment) or part qualification (containing unit of competency TAEASS502 – Design and Develop Assessment Tools) to meet the new qualification or assessor skills set requirements under the Standards for Registered Training Organisations.

The updated policy also includes an amendment to the application process required for a provider to deliver the TAE40116 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment qualification under Smart and Skilled.
