FEE FREE TRAINEESHIPS – FOR TRAINING STARTING ON OR AFTER JANUARY 2020

Smart and Skilled training will be fee free for NSW trainees and school based trainees who commence their traineeship qualification on or after 1 January 2020 through the Smart and Skilled Fee Free Traineeship Initiative.

Under this arrangement, the Department will pay the full student fee to the provider on behalf of the trainee. The subsidy will therefore cover the total cost of the training (i.e. the qualification price).

Fee free training will be available to commencing trainees for four years, until 31 December 2023.

Trainees will be eligible for up to three fee free traineeships over the duration of the initiative.

a. Smart and Skilled Fee Free Traineeships Policy

The Smart and Skilled Policy for the Fee Free Traineeship Initiative, which includes the eligibility criteria, is attached.

Providers must comply with this policy. The Department will monitor compliance and failure to comply with the policy is an Event of Default, in accordance with clause 13 of the Smart and Skilled contract. This may lead to suspension or termination of a provider's Smart and Skilled contract.



The policy is also available at STS Online > Smart and Skilled Contract Management > Support Documents.

b. Notifying the Department of enrolments under this initiative

Providers will be able to submit Notification of Enrolments in the Provider Calculator for eligible trainees using the fee waiver function from today.

A fact sheet on how to do this using the single student and multiple student process is attached and is also available at STS Online > Smart and Skilled Contract Management > Support Documents.

It is your responsibility to ensure that all eligible trainees are enrolled under this initiative.

c. Eligible trainees that have been enrolled prior to today

Trainees that have already enrolled with a training start date of 1 January 2020 or later and meet the eligibility criteria will also be able to access fee free training.

The Department will retrospectively adjust the enrolment in the Smart and Skilled database and apply the fee waiver for any affected trainees. Emails will be sent to providers of any affected trainees once this is done.

On receipt of the email providers must let affected trainees know that their training is free and must refund to them or their employer (if the employer has paid) any fees paid to date.

d. Fee Administration Policies

The Smart and Skilled Fee Administration Policy and the School Based Apprenticeships and Traineeships Program Fee Administration Policy have been updated to reflect the changes to traineeship fees. Copies of these updated policies are attached.

2. NSW SKILLS LIST AND SMART AND SKILLED PRICES AND FEES SCHEDULE UPDATED – VERSIONS 9.2 AND 10.1 RELEASED

The NSW Skills List and the Smart and Skilled Prices and Fees Schedule have been updated.

The updates cover changes as a result of:

- the addition of a new qualification
- updates to Training Packages
- changes to Vocational Training Orders (VTOs) for superseding qualifications
- the introduction of the Fee Free Traineeships Initiative.

Version 9.2 takes effect as of 28 October 2019, while version 10.1 applies to all training commencing on or after 1 January 2020.

a. New qualification on the NSW Skills List

The Department of Education has completed the first of its half-yearly NSW Skills List reviews planned for 2019.

The Department has priced the Certificate IV in Farriery (ACM40818) on its own merits. This was warranted as it has an increased AQF level compared to the qualification it is replacing (ACM30517), indicating that there are significant differences in composition between the two qualifications. The price of the Certificate IV in Farriery has therefore increased to reflect its greater complexity. The student fees for the Certificate IV in Farriery under the Smart and Skilled Targeted Priorities Full Qualification (TPFQ) pathway have also increased to reflect the change in AQF level. The increased price and fees are shown in **Table 4**.

All other superseding qualifications in **Table 3** retain the same prices and fees as their superseded versions.
