QUALIFICATION DESCRIPTION	<p>This qualification reflects the role of individuals in the community and residential setting who work under supervision as a part of a multi-disciplinary team, following an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support, working independently and taking responsibility for own outputs within the scope of the job role. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.</p> <p>To achieve this qualification, the candidate must have completed at least 120 hours of work as detailed in the Assessment Requirements of the units of competency.</p> <p>No licensing, legislative, regulatory or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>
