At this level, workers may be involved in both formal and informal facilitation of learning, including for those students in need of additional support. In these roles, the education support worker sources and analyses information from diverse sources, may work with limited direct supervision and could provide guidance to other workers.</p> <p>Education support workers work mainly with students in classroom settings in primary and secondary schools, as defined by state and territory legislation.</p> <p>No licensing, legislative or certification requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.</p>
